

Love One Another



Reading: Based on 1 Peter 3:13-22

Christians are called to love one another. When someone does wrong against us, we should not do wrong against them. We should run from things that are bad and try our very best to do good. In our homes, communities, and churches, we should always treat one another with kindness and respect. Pray that God will help you to live this way.

Objective:

- Teachers discusses the reading based on 1 Peter 3:13-22
- Students created a collage depicting “Love One Another”.

Materials:

Template for heart	Color paper	Scissors
Template for girl and boy	Markers	Pencil
Template for love one another	Glue	Paper clips

Steps:

1. Teacher prepares materials.
 - Prints templates.
 - Creates an example.

Places heart shape template over color paper.
Folds both in half. Use paper clip to hold in place.
Cut out heart shape and cut out inside heart shape.
Hold cut out shape over template for love one another. Love one another will be the background. Use paper clip to hold in place.
Use pencil to mark inside heart on love one another template.
Color inside of heart. Students should color a pattern they like.
Glue heart template on background.
Place girl and boy templates over color paper. Use paper clip to hold in place.
Cut out girl and boy. They can cut 2 or more figures.
Glue figures over heart.
2. Teacher reads and discusses reading based on 1 Peter 3:13-22.
3. Teacher models how to begin activity.
4. Students make “Love One Another” collage. Allow students to choose colors.
